CHAPTER SEAL

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Each year the Pan-Rhodian Society “APOLLON” offers a small number of scholarships to talented students of the APOLLON family.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicant must be a Rhodian (see Section 6 below for definition) member of the Society or of Rhodian descent whose either parent is a Society member.
- B. Applicant must be a fully matriculated student in an accredited four-year college or university and must have completed his/her first year of study. Community, junior colleges and vocational trade schools, etc. are excluded.
- C. Applicant must have a good academic record—a C+ average or better—and must be registered in courses of at least 12 points or credits.
- D. Application must be received at least three (3) months before the Society’s annual convention.

3. DOCUMENTS

To qualify, an applicant must submit the following documents:

- A. A transcript of his/her college record of the two most recent academic terms. The record should include his/her class rank.
- B. A fully completed application.
- C. Two letters of recommendation.

4. RESPONSIBILITY

Applicant is responsible for gathering and submitting all essential information herein requested and for submitting it as indicated in Section 2 above. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

5. SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

All applications are referred to a committee of two non-Rhodian university or college professors and one Rhodian professor, or to the Society’s legal counsel. Their selection is final. The committee’s evaluation of each application is referred to the convention, which decides the number and amount of each scholarship.

6. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- A. Definition of the term “Rhodian”.... Anyone born on the Island of Rhodes and his/her descendants; a spouse of a Rhodian and his/her descendants.
- B. Applicant will be notified as soon as possible after the convention.
- C. Checks will be mailed directly to the institution applicant is attending.
